KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

 - Attend trainings that relate to pre-school/children's ministry, or upon request
 - Take initiative in interacting and playing with the children, as well as checking for and promptly changing dirty or wet diapers
- 2. Welcome parents and children cordially, consistently, and professionally
 - Greet and interact with parents
 - Use discernment and relational skills in helping both children and parents during drop-off and pick-up times
- 3. Ensure the ongoing safety of the children entrusted to the ministry's care
 - Understand and communicate the policies and best practices to volunteers and parents as they relate to children's safety
 - Check all areas that will have children in them prior to an event to ensure they are clean and free of anything unsafe or inappropriate for children
 - Communicate with the Nursery Coordinator or Associate Pastor and the parents, as appropriate, in the case of a reportable incident

- Experience in caring for children ages birth 5th grade
- Reliable and punctual
- Able to consistently present oneself in appropriate attire and demeanor
- Successful background and reference checks
- Up-to-date on all appropriate immunizations
