

Bethany West Seattle Worship Director

Purpose: The Worship Director will work alongside the Lead Pastor in carrying out the vision for the Worship Ministry at Bethany West Seattle through leading Sunday worship and other ministry-related activities.

Reports to: Bethany West Seattle, Lead Pastor

Worship Director:

1. Design, execute and lead high-quality, engaging times of worship across all services at Bethany West Seattle.
2. Model the role of worshipper and worship leader—to our congregation and worship teams—by leading worship on a consistent basis.
3. Recruit, train, organize and shepherd teams of volunteer worship leaders (musicians, sound/media and set-up/tear-down).
4. Lead worship volunteers towards growth in both musical and spiritual leadership of the congregation.
5. Drive our efforts toward excellence and quality in worship by providing opportunities for training and feedback.
6. Coordinate weekly rehearsals and oversee set-up/tear-down of worship space.
7. Work with Lead Pastor and key leaders to engage the arts in worship.
8. Participate in bi-weekly staff meetings and weekly one-on-one meetings with Lead Pastor.
9. Work with Green Lake Director of Worship to ensure continuity across other locations where needed and appropriate.

Position Requirements:

- Passion for making Christ more fully known in the West Seattle community.

- Strong spiritual commitment to Jesus Christ and demonstrates a Christ-led way of living.
- He or she exemplifies Biblical leadership principles found in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9 and Philippians 2:3-5.
- A loyal and humble team player who is able to submit to church leadership.
- Committed to the mission, values, and vision of Bethany Community Church.

- Makes a positive contribution to a staff culture that increasingly embodies excellence, competency and the ethics of servant leadership demonstrated by Christ.

- 5+ years of experience leading worship.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

- Experience with Front-of-House sound and both digital and analog mixers.
