Director of Worship

Summary: The Director of Worship works alongside the Lead Pastor in crafting and carrying out the vision for worship ministry at Bethany Northeast. The role includes ownership across all aspects of the Sunday worship service and other ministry-related activities and endeavors.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Cultivate and lead worship ministry teams and the congregation in participatory worship that empowers Bethany Northeast to embody the fullness of God
- Own and manage the location worship experience in-person and online, aligning with the Lead Pastor's vision and messaging each week.
- Collaborate with the Lead Pastor in expanding Bethany Northeast's engagement of worship from a variety of cultural, and stylistic expressions
- Ensure all worship services are covered with personnel in the areas of worship leaders, musicians, and technical support/production.
- Recruit, train, equip, and shepherd ministry team members to grow their giftings for corporate worship as worship leaders, musicians, and technical support/production.
- Participate as a member of the Bethany Northeast and Bethany Community Church Staff
- Perform other duties as the situation arises/assigned by their manager

Work Schedule: Typical work schedule is Sunday through Thursday, 21 hours/week.
