JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Director of Family and Outreach Ministries, Bethany Eastside**

**Summary:** The Director of Family and Outreach Ministries inspires and leads the congregation in the spiritual formation of children, youth, and families, and creates opportunities to build deeper connections with the greater community through local missions and school partnerships.

**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Create and oversee dynamic ministries that lead children and youth into a growing relationship with Christ and empower families/caretakers to become primary nurturers of their children's faith
  - Create, plan, and oversee Sunday worship and learning experiences for children and youth
  - Implement and customize age-appropriate curriculum that engages children and youth of diverse backgrounds (culturally, ethnically, and socio-economically) and nurtures faith in Jesus
  - Create a vibrant and dynamic discipleship environment through managing Family Ministry areas that are safe, clean, and appealing to children and families
  - Establish healthy lines of communication between Family Ministries and the life of the church while maintaining a posture of inclusion and focus on kids and families who are not yet part of our church
  - Develop and expand Family Ministries programming to include greater discipleship and outreach opportunities (e.g. music, midweek events, serving, seminars, etc.)
- Shepherd and equip robust volunteer teams for Family Ministries
  - Recruit, equip, and empower volunteers of various backgrounds and life stages to maximize influence and reach
  - Design and build a Family Ministry Leadership Team, including high-level volunteers who serve and lead other volunteers within the ministry
  - Cast vision and craft strategy with volunteers for a long-term (5+ years) plan for Family Ministries
- Oversee Outreach Ministries
  - Identify and build a strong relationship between Bethany Eastside and a local school, positioning our congregation to meet the needs of students, staff, and key leaders with creativity and love
  - Organize and deploy local outreach teams for church-wide events such as BCC Serve Day and Jubilee REACH Serve Day
  - Empower congregants to connect with local outreach/mission groups and para-church ministry staff
- Perform other duties as a member of the Bethany Eastside and Bethany Community Church Staff, or as the situation arises/assigned by supervisor

<i>Work Schedule:</i>	Typical work schedule is Sunday through Thursday, 21+ hours/week. Must be available on Mondays at Bethany Green Lake and Sundays on the Eastside.
<i>Physical Demands:</i>	Must be able to work in a mobile environment. Must be able to help with event and weekend set up, if needed. Must be able to lift small boxes and/or equipment up to 40lbs.
<i>Working Conditions</i>	Due to seasonal activity, job duties may often require additional hours and availability outside normal working hours. May require flexibility to adjust work schedule from time to time to work early or later than regular schedule. The office environment is fast-paced and may be considered stressful, due to seemingly regular interruptions because of numerous urgent and unexpected requests that requires multi-tasking.
