Family Ministry Seasonal Staff - Green Lake

Summary: The Family Ministry Seasonal Staff serves with Family Ministries, participates in planning, preparation and support for Sunday Morning Children's program and special events, collaborates with the Family Ministry Team to love, inspire, and equip children, their families, and volunteers to express Christ in their daily lives.

Classification: Part-Time (12 hours), Temporary: March 1, 2023 – May 31, 2023

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt, Part-time

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provides program leadership and support for Sunday Morning Family Ministry programming in three key areas:
 - Ensure thriving volunteers
 - Collaboration with Family Ministry Associate for curriculum and classroom prep
 - Provide encouragement for parents
2. Collaborates with Pastor of Children, Youth and Family, Associate Director of Early Adolescent Ministries and Family Ministries Associate to engage with, and support Tween group, Pint Size Choir, and other Children's ministry special events
 - a. Including but not limited to: check-in, event prep, volunteer assignments, planning of games and activities, media technology, and talks.
3. Collaborate to support other projects within the Children's Ministry, Youth Ministry, and Belong Ministry in coordination with CYFM Team.
4. Participate as a staff member of the Family Ministry Team, Bethany Green Lake and Bethany Community Church, and perform other duties as the situation arises/assigned by supervisor.

Work Schedule: Typical work hours include Sunday Mornings (appr. 6 hrs.) with the remaining hours (appr. 6 hrs.) varying as determined by employee and manager, with some evenings, early mornings and specific meetings required.

Physical Demands: Must be able to work in an office environment, often at a computer workstation. Must be able to move between buildings on campus. Must be able to lift small boxes and/or equipment up to 40lbs.

Working Conditions: Due to seasonal activity, job duties may often require additional hours and availability outside normal working hours. May require flexibility to adjust work schedule from time to time to work early or later than regular schedule.

The office environment is fast-paced and may be considered stressful. Must be able to adapt your approach and priorities in real-time based on shifting demands.
